## Minutes from ANNUAL MEETING

## President report:

It was reported at the annual meeting that we didn't have enough member for a quorum. Therefore, the meeting was going to be conducted with no formal action taken.

- 4) Problems and issues the board of directors dealt with over the past year:
  - a. Members not complying with covenants requirements on house paint exterior colors.
  - b. Trash and recycling bins stored in manner that would keep them obstructed.
  - c. Members maintaining their front yards free from weeds.
  - d. President will follow-up when members do car repairs. Will visit with the home owner.
  - e. Speeding and other issues on Golf Club Road. Radar testing on Golf Club Rd. was to determined if additional traffic enforcement was required or to see if the speed limit needed to be adjusted.

Vice presidents report:

- 1) We use Extreme Landscaping. They didn't raise their rates and were provided with a 4 year contract last year. This year we had to spend additional funds on and repair. These repairs, did not included normal maintenance.
  - a. Action required on advising Xtreme that they need to maintain the sidewalk area the length of Golf Club Road.
  - b. The bushes on El Segundo and Golf Club need trimming due to traffic hazard.
  - c. Will contact the golf course to see if they can clean up some the area that are off Golf Club and near the mail box area.
  - d. Contact the appropriate party on the area at the northeast corner of Roadrunner and Golf Club.
- 2) Our members are good at complying with keeping their Recreation Vehicles off the street or drive way, except for their preparation and maintenance.

President and Charlie from our account firm went over the financial report and the proposed budget for 2024. Questions were raised regarding the amount in our reserved. The amount is in compliance with State Law.
